- Voluntary Centre Edinburgh
  - o Promote volunteering and recruit volunteers
  - o This provides good experience for the long term unemployed to get back to work
  - o ESF and BLF funding has been gained in order to promote volunteering to long term unemployed.

  - o Supported employment Services operating in Edinburgh and mid-lothian but interested in expanding.
  - o Part of a consortium in Edinburgh to deliver better joined up services.

  - o Good Food Project – homeless and socially excluded people
